Town Quay by the Swing Bridge beside TS Hazard, Faversham's original town warehouse, on Conduit Street ME13 7DF

**9.00am** - Fish, freshly landed in the heart of Faversham from the lovely '**Louise**' of **Hollowshore Fisheries**. High tide is at 9.00am from when we plan to have freshly landed fish for sale. '**Louise**', **Wink** and **Bluey** will be formally welcomed to land their fish by **Shiel Campbell**, **Faversham's Mayor**. Come and see what the morning's catch has brought in.

This is a rare event these days and a reminder of Faversham Creek's busy history of fisheries and trade. Don't miss it!



**10.00am to 4.00pm** - Faversham's famous **Charter Market**. Faversham has had a Charter Market for over 900 years and is one of the oldest in the country, mentioned in the Domesday Book 1086. *Come and enjoy!*

**10.00am to 3.30pm** - Tesco has a sustainable mackerel tasting session for children and adults at their town centre store.
